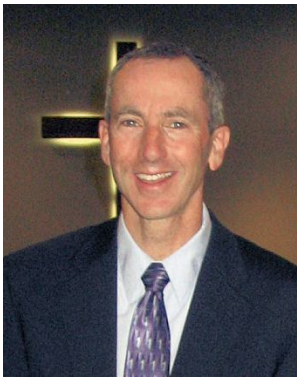

Prayer Service: Wednesday evenings at 7:00 p.m.

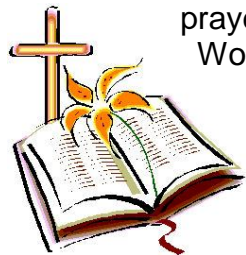
Bible Studies: Adult Bible Study, Sunday at 11:10 a.m.
